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INTRODUCTION

Puducherry, a small Union Territory on the East Coast of India extends over an area of 490 Sq.Kms. It comprises of four geographically non-contiguous regions namely Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam. Puducherry, the capital of the U.T is on the East Coast and South of Chennai at a distance of 162 Kms. Karaikal lies at 130 Kms. South of Puducherry. Mahe is situated near Tellicherry, geographically between Calicut and Cannanure district of Kerala at a distance of 850 Kms from Puducherry. Yanam is situated on the East Coast geographically as an enclave of East Godavari district of Andhra Pradesh and politically forming part of the U.T. of Puducherry at a distance of 870 Kms (North) from Puducherry. The Union Territory of Puducherry consists of two districts viz., Puducherry District comprising of Puducherry, Mahe and Yanam regions and Karaikal district comprising of Karaikal region.
