The Agricultural Sector is the base for estimation of State Domestic Product under Secondary and Tertiary Sectors. So, the data analysis and inference of reliable Agriculture Statistics and its accuracy is very important.

This report has been designed to serve the policy makers, dealing with preparation of production plans for food and other agriculture policies. This report provides data on agriculture, rainfall including seasonal conditions, prices of agricultural commodities and wages of agricultural labour. This report, sixty second in its series, has been classified into three divisions, where Part-I briefly gives an account of population, rainfall and seasonal conditions, classification of area, area of crops irrigated and the area under all crops as well as production and yield particulars. Part-II contains summary tables of the Union Territory as a whole for the last five years enabling comparison over a period of time. Part-III of this publication presents region - wise statistics for the year under reference.

I wish to record my special appreciation to Shri. M. Ayyamperumal, Deputy Director, Tmt. K. Akila, Statistical Officer and other dedicated team of officials of the Agricultural Statistics Section for their kind support in bringing out this publication in time. Suggestions for the improvement of this publication are highly solicited.

PART - I

INTRODUCTION

Puducherry, a small Union Territory on the East Coast of India extends over an area of 486.51 Sq.Kms (as per village papers). It comprises of four geographically non-contiguous regions namely Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam. Puducherry, the capital of the U.T is on the East Coast and South of Chennai at a distance of 162 Kms. Karaikal lies at 130 Kms. South of Puducherry. Mahe is situated near Tellicherry, geographically between Kozhikode and Cannanore District of Kerala at a distance of 850 Kms from Puducherry. Yanam is situated on the East Coast geographically as an enclave of East Godavari District of Andhra Pradesh and politically forming part of the U.T. of Puducherry at a distance of 870 Kms (North) from Puducherry. The Union Territory of Puducherry (UTP) consists of two districts viz., Puducherry District comprising of Puducherry, Mahe and Yanam regions and Karaikal District comprising of Karaikal region.

The Revised Estimates of GSDP of Puducherry in 2023-24 has been worked out to Rs.47,901.95 Crores at current prices. The per capita income (on the base of NSDP current) for the year 2023-24 (Revised Estimates) has been estimated at Rs.2,62,166/-. The sectoral composition of the GSDP at current prices in 2023-24 (Revised Estimates) indicates that the percentage share of Primary, Secondary and Tertiary sectors as 5.62%, 41.66% and 52.72% respectively.

STATISTICAL SCENARIO IN THE U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY

With the increasing involvement of the state in welfare activities, there is a growing need for statistics in all productive activities and their presentation in a meaningful framework to facilitate decision making. This led to the creation of Directorates of Economics and Statistics (DES) in all States and Union Territories. For the purpose of co-ordination of Statistical activities of the Union Territory of Puducherry and for the promotion of Statistical standards, the Directorate of Economics and Statistics was set up in August 1957 in the U.T of Puducherry.

The main thrust of the Directorate in the initial years was to serve as a focal point of information on various subject matter fields of statistics. DES has been declared as Nodal Agency for all the statistical activities of the Union Territory of Puducherry during 1982. Since then DES is acting as the Nodal Agency and Statistical Authority for developing and managing the statistical system in the Union Territory.

The Directorate has witnessed continuous growth over the years and the responsibilities of the Directorate both in terms of scope and nature of work has increased considerably. The Statistical Science has assumed paramount importance for socio-economic planning and policy formulation in recent years. DES plays a key role in building up of a sound data base covering various sectors of the U.T economy and provides valuable inputs for planning and policy formulation.

The Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Government of Puducherry is declared as the State Agricultural Statistics Authority (SASA) and the scheme viz “ Collection of Agricultural Statistics” is being implemented in Puducherry Region since 1961-62 and in phases, this scheme was extended to the other three regions of the Union Territory of Puducherry. The Field Supervisors of this Directorate, are responsible for the collection of field level statistics in the three seasons of an agricultural year. These primary workers visit each and every plot and collect “Land Utilization Statistics” with the help of village maps supplied by the Revenue Department, Puducherry. The supervisory staff of the Directorate provide able guidance to the primary enumerators in carrying out their work successfully and scientifically.

POPULATION

The population of the U.T of Puducherry as per 2011 Census was 12.47 lakhs and the Decadal Population growth rate is 28.1%. The density of population has increased from 769 persons per Sq. Km in 1961 to 2547 persons in 2011. The literacy rate has increased from 37.43% in 1961 census to 85.9% in 2011 census during the period of 50 years.

Of the Total Population, 6,12,511 persons were males and 6,35,442 persons were females, with a sex ratio of 1037 females to 1000 males. The regional break up figures with density of population are given below.

The rural population is 3,95,200 persons (31.67%) whereas the urban population is 8,52,753 persons which constitutes (68.33%) of the total population. The percentage of rural population had decreased from 33.43% to 31.67% compared to previous census.

The following table reveals the available working force in the U.T. of Puducherry as per 2011 Census.

The total Population of the Union Territory of Puducherry is 12,47,953 persons and out of this 4,44,968 (35.66%) are classified as workers. Agriculture Sector of the U.T.of Puducherry had employed 80,490 persons who are either Cultivators or Agricultural Labourers. The above table gives the detailed picture of workforce of the Union Territory on the Agricultural Sector.

RAINFALL AND SEASONAL CONDITION

The Union Territory of Puducherry receives rainfall both from “South – West monsoon” and “North–East monsoon.”

The monsoon period (June to May) is divided into four seasons namely,

- (i) South–West monsoon
- (ii) North–East monsoon
- (iii) Winter period
- (iv) Hot weather period.

SOUTH–WEST MONSOON (JUNE 2023 TO SEPTEMBER 2023)

This season’s rainfall plays a vital role in the production of Khariff Crops. Mahe region which is located in the West coast of Kerala State receives its major rainfall during this season. The region–wise rainfall during the South-West monsoon season is given below.

It may be noted that Puducherry region had recorded a higher level of rainfall while compared to normal rainfall during the season whereas Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam regions had recorded the lesser level of rainfall as compared to their normal rainfall.

NORTH-EAST MONSOON (OCTOBER 2023 TO DECEMBER 2023)

The region-wise rainfall during the North-East Monsoon season is shown in the following table:

During this season, Karaikal region received more rainfall than normal, all the other three regions Puducherry, Mahe and Yanam regions in the U. T. of Puducherry had received less level of rainfall as compared to their normal rainfall.

WINTER PERIOD (JANUARY 2024 - FEBRUARY 2024)

The region – wise rainfall during the winter season is presented in the following table:

During this season, three regions Puducherry, Karaikal and Mahe regions had received higher level of rainfall as compared to their normal rainfall. Yanam region had no rainfall during this season.

HOT-WEATHER PERIOD (MARCH 2024 TO MAY 2024)

The above season's rainfall details are given in the following table.

During the above season, Mahe received more rainfall than the normal rainfall whereas Puducherry, Karaikal and Yanam regions received less level of rainfall than normal.

RAINFALL ABNORMALITIES

The rainfall abnormalities are classified as follows

- i) Excess (+) 20% and above
- ii) Normal (+) 19.9% to (-) 19.9%
- iii) Deficient (-) 20% to (-) 59.9%
- iv) Scanty (-) 60% to (-) 99.9%
- v) No rain (-) 100%

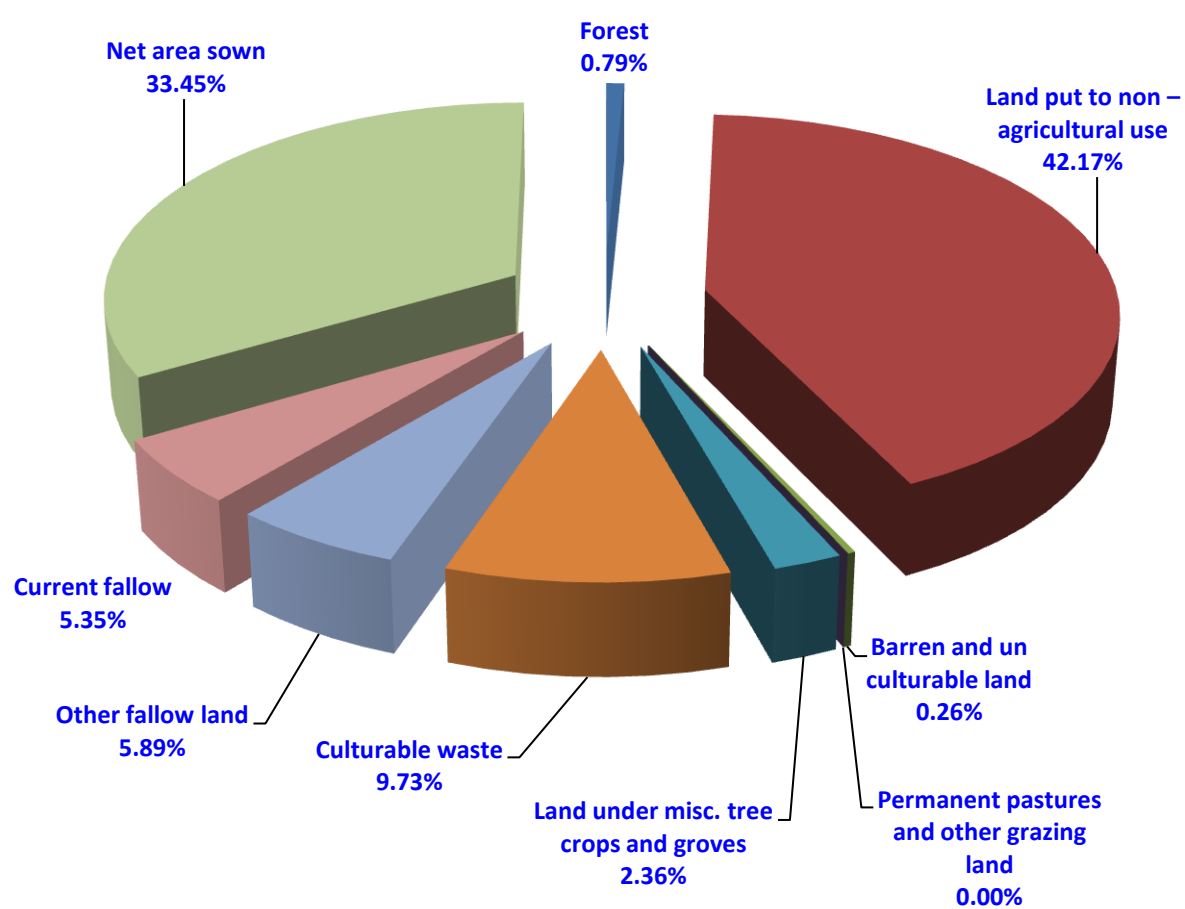
CLASSIFICATION OF AREA

The total geographical area of the Union Territory of Puducherry is 486.51 Sq. Km according to the village papers, which is classified into nine categories.

The following table gives the nine fold classification of land utilization and the area under each category with its respective percentage to the total geographical area.

CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

FOREST

Lands classified as “Forest” under any legal enactment are dealing with forests or administered as forests whether, State owned or private. During the year 2023-24, area under this category was 384 hectares (0.79 %) of the total geographical area as declared by the Department of Forest, Government of Puducherry.

LAND PUT TO NON-AGRICULTURAL USE

All lands occupied by Buildings, Paths, Roads, Railways, Rivers, Ponds, Lakes, Canals and other lands put to non-agricultural purposes are brought under this category.

During the year 2023-24, area under this category was 20,516 hectares (42.17%) of the total geographical area, which was 20,256 hectares in the previous year 2022-23, which shows 0.53% higher when compared to 2022-23.

BARREN AND UNCULTURABLE LANDS

Land where cultivation is not at all possible comes under this category. During the year 2023-24, 125 hectares (0.26%) were under this category.

PERMANENT PASTURES AND OTHER GRAZING LANDS

All grazing lands, whether they are permanent pastures or meadows are considered as permanent pastures and other grazing lands according to their nature. Like in previous year 2022-23, no area was recorded under this category during the year 2023-24.

LAND UNDER MISCELLANEOUS TREE CROPS & GROVES

Lands in which trees and groves are grown which are not included in the net area sown come under this category. An area of 1,150 hectares (2.36%) was recorded under this category. This shows a decrease of 82 hectare under this category when compared to the last agricultural year.

CULTURABLE WASTE

All lands available for cultivation whether taken up for cultivation or not taken up for cultivation once, but not cultivated during the current year and continuously for the last five years or more, in succession for one reason or the other, are classified as culturable waste. During the year 2023-24, an area of 4,735 hectares has been recorded under this category, which constitutes 9.73% of the total geographical area. This shows an increase of 94 hectares when compared to the previous year 2022-23.

OTHER FALLOW LANDS

All lands, which are usually taken up for cultivation but are temporarily suspended from cultivation for a period of not less than one year and not more than five years are considered as other fallow lands. An area of 2,865 hectares has been recorded during the year 2023-24 under this category which is 5.89% of the total geographical area.

CURRENT FALLOWS

Cultivable lands, which are kept fallow during the entire period under review, are known as current fallows. During 2023-24, lands under this category were recorded as 2,602 hectares which is 5.35%.

NET AREA SOWN

Net area sown represents the area sown with crops at least once in any of the crop season of the year, area sown more than once in the same year, will count only once. The net area sown in the current year 2023-24 was 16,274 hectares as (33.45 %) against 16,448 hectares (33.81 %) recorded last year (2022-23) which is a decrease of 174 hectares (0.36 %)

The table below represents the region-wise distribution of Net Area Sown to their respective geographical area for the year 2023-24.

TOTAL CROPPED AREA (GROSS CROPPED AREA)

The Total Cropped area was recorded as 30,416 hectares during the year 2023-24 as against 29,927 hectares registering an increase of 489 hectares over previous year. The area sown more than once was reported as 14,142 hectares during 2023-24 as compared to 13,479 hectares during the year 2022-23, showing an increase of 663 hectares.

AREA IRRIGATED BY DIFFERENT SOURCES OF IRRIGATION

The Net Area Irrigated by different sources of irrigation during the year 2023-24 is recorded as 15,855 hectares. In Puducherry region, 62.14% is irrigated to the total net area irrigated, while in Karaikal region the respective figure is 35.17%. The relevant figures for Mahe and Yanam regions are 0.16 % and 2.53 % respectively.

The following table shows the Net Area Irrigated by different sources of irrigation in respect of the Union Territory of Puducherry.

It may be noted that, out of 15,855 hectares of net area irrigated, a total of 4,799 hectares in Karaikal & Yanam regions were irrigated through canals. In Puducherry region the main source of irrigation was “Tube Wells” and the area irrigated through “Tube Wells” in the U.T of Puducherry was 11,020 hectares, of which Puducherry region occupied 9,852 hectares under Tube Wells irrigation.

During the year 2023-24, the Gross area irrigated under different sources of irrigation was 25,951 hectares as against 25,317 hectares in 2022-23. Percentage of area irrigated to total cropped area was 85.32 % in the Union Territory of Puducherry. It is worth mentioning here that 85.87 % of the total cropped area in Puducherry region alone as irrigated whereas the figures for Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam regions were 88.46 %, 5.18 % and 96.86 % respectively.

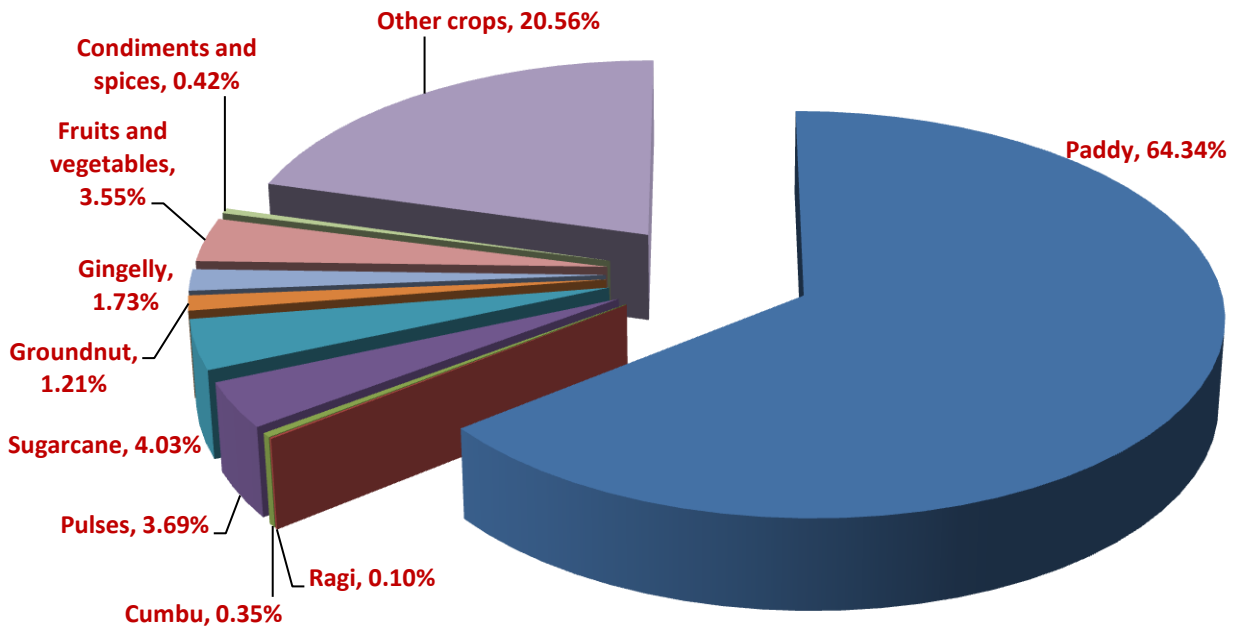

The total cropped area under all crops was 30,416 hectares (Food crops 23,333 hectares & Non-food crops 7,083 hectares) in 2023-24 which is an increase by 489 hectares as compared to 2022-23. During the year 2023-24, the area under food crops accounted for 76.71 % and non-food crops 23.29 %.

In Puducherry region, food crops occupied 74.34% of the total food cropped area whereas in Karaikal region it was 24.37% and in Mahe and Yanam regions the same were 0.42% and 0.87% respectively.

PADDY

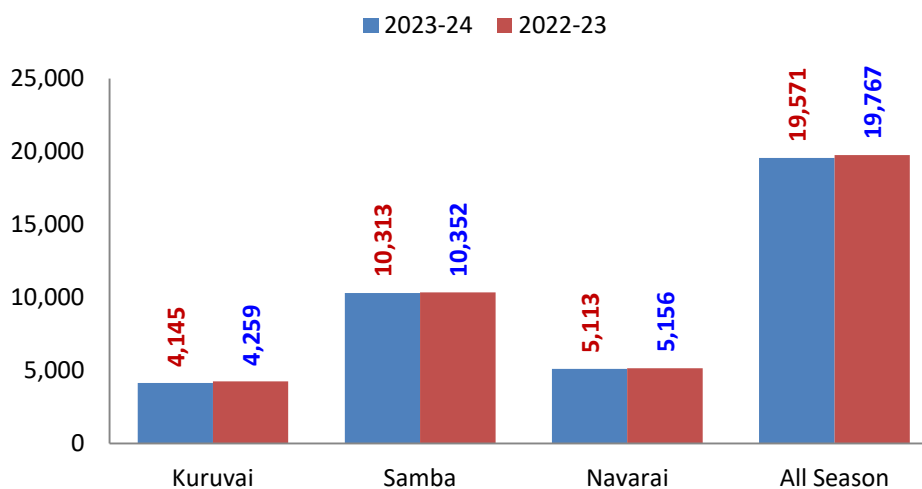
Paddy is the principal crop amongst all the crops and Paddy was raised in an area of 19,571 hectares during the year 2023-24 which accounted for 64.34% of the total cropped area. The area under Paddy in 2022-23 was 19,767 hectares. Production of Rice during 2023-24 was reported as 61,299 tonnes as against 65,324 tonnes in 2022-23. The average yield rate of rice was 3,132 Kgs. per hectare during 2023-24.

Percentage of area under Paddy to the total cropped area in respect of each region of Union Territory of Puducherry can be observed from the following table.

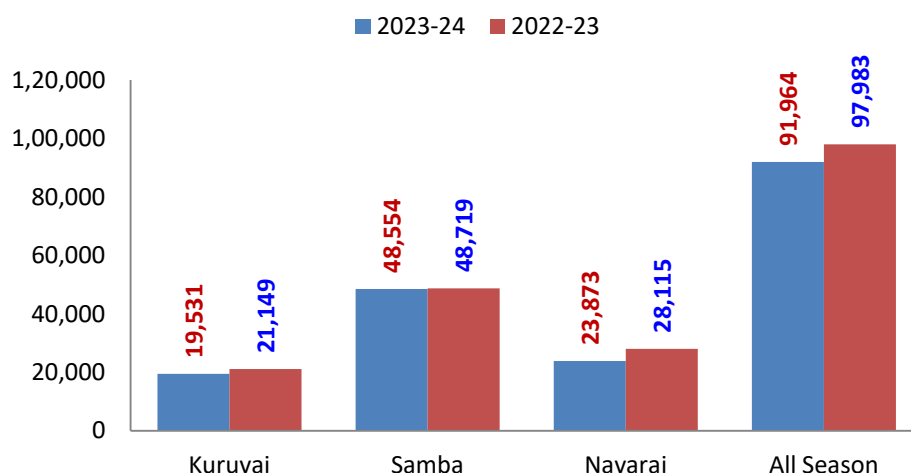

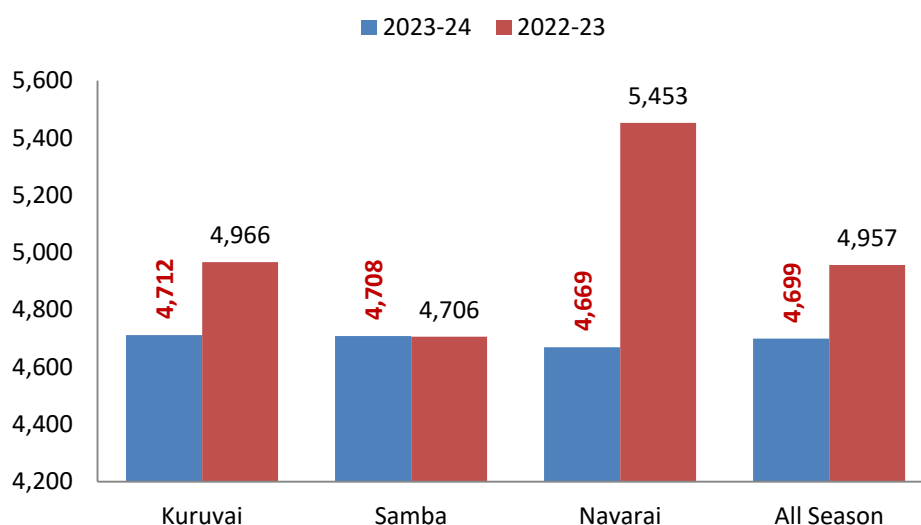
Area (in Hec)

Paddy is normally cultivated in wetlands, which are irrigated by different sources of irrigation such as Canals and Tube Wells. Usually Paddy is cultivated during three different seasons in a year. Paddy first crop (Kuruvai) is normally sown during the months of May to July and harvested during September to October. Paddy second crop (Samba), which is predominant, is sown during the period from August to October and harvested during December to February. The sowing season of Paddy third crop (Navarai) is sown from January to March and is harvested during May to June.

RAGI

Ragi was cultivated in Puducherry region to an extent of 31 hectares. This crop is mainly sown in dry lands irrigated by tube wells.

The production was estimated at 91 tonnes. About 0.10% of total cropped area was utilized for Ragi cultivation.

CUMBU

Cumbu was cultivated only in Puducherry region to an extent of 106 hectares in 2023-24 and the production was 318 tonnes. Cumbu is mainly sown in dry lands for three seasons viz. Khariff, Rabi-I and Rabi-II.

OTHER MILLETS

Other Millets such as cholam and Thenai had been grown in Puducherry region alone to an extent of 7 hectare and 1 hectare respectively. The production of cholam and Thenai was estimated at 22 tonnes during the agricultural year under review.

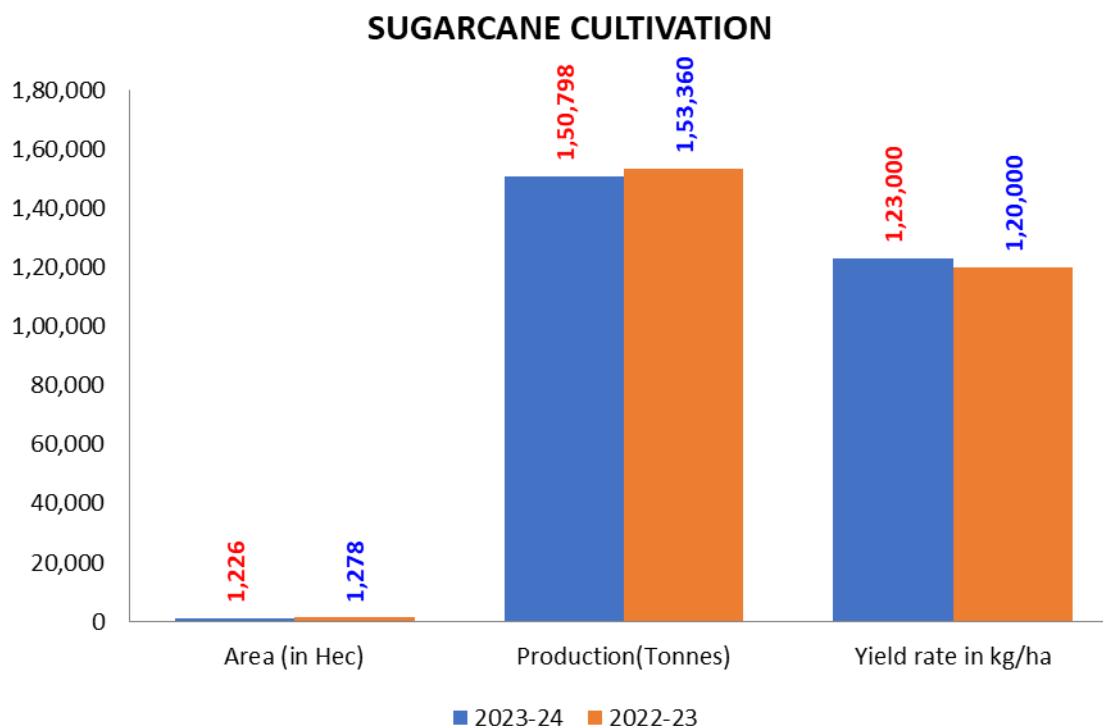
PULSES

Pulses were cultivated in 1,123 hectares in the entire Union Territory and the Blackgram and Greengram occupied 417 hectares and 325 hectares respectively, other pulses (Karamani) occupied 381 hectares. The production of Blackgram was 378 tonnes and that of Greengram was 82 tonnes respectively. The production of other pulses was 343 tonnes.

SUGARCANE

Sugarcane is the major crop among the commercial crops and grown in Puducherry region only. During the year 2023-24, Sugarcane was cultivated in 1,226 hectares. The production of Sugarcane during the year 2023-24 was estimated as 123 tonnes as against 120 tonnes per hectare during 2022–23, showing an increase of 3 tonnes per hectare.

COTTON

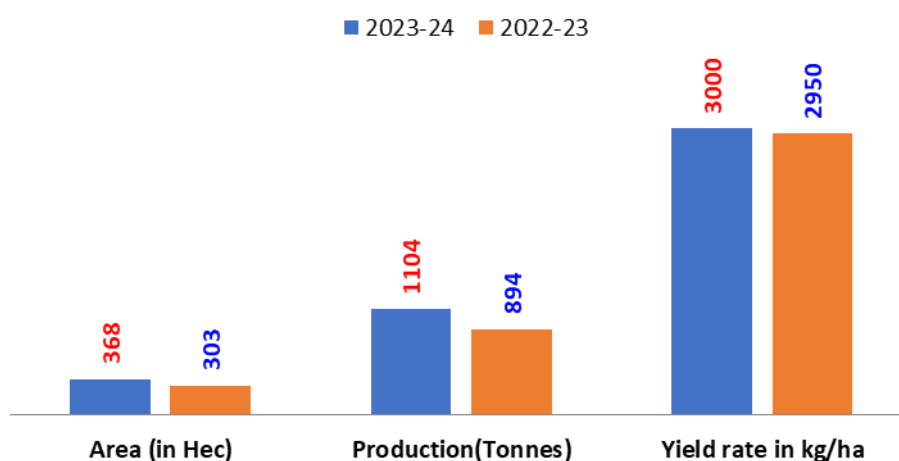
Cotton is the only fibre crop grown mainly in Karaikal region. During 2023-24 total area under Cotton was reported as 1,029 hectares of which 7 hectare was recorded in Puducherry and 1,022 hectares was recorded in Karaikal region. Total out-turn of Cotton was reported as 2,043 metric tonnes.

GROUNDNUT

Groundnut is one among the leading Oilseeds cultivated in the Union Territory of Puducherry. During the year 2023-24, the cropped area under Groundnut was reported as 368 hectares which is 1.21% of the total cropped area and the total production was estimated at 1,104 metric tonnes as compared to 894 metric tonnes in 2022-23. Groundnut is sown as an irrigated crop during December to February and in July and August of a year.

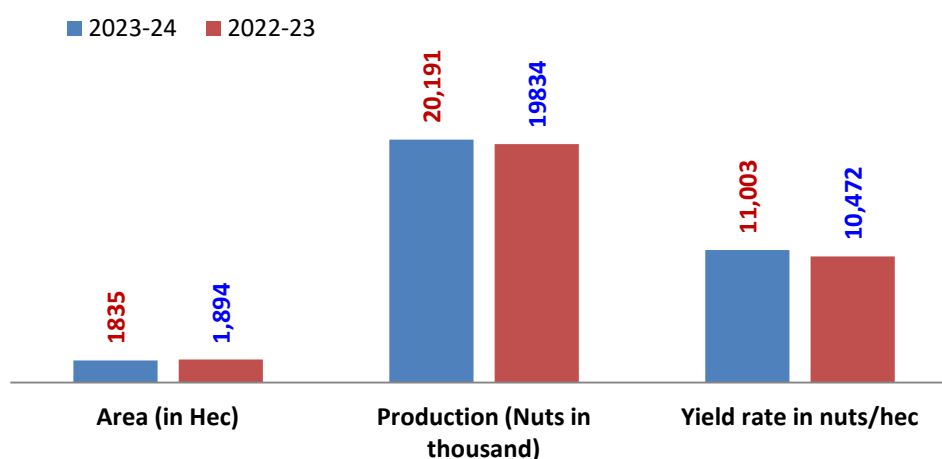


COCONUT

Coconut is an another important oil seed crop, cultivated in 1,835 hectares during 2023-24, of which 1003 hectares was in Puducherry region, 160 hectares in Karaikal, 404 hectares in Mahe region and 268 hectares in Yanam region. It is significant to note that in Mahe, 80.48% of the total cropped area was occupied by Coconut.

GINGELLY

Gingelly was sown in an area of 527 hectares in 2023-24 as against 676 hectares during 2022–23 with an average yield of 806 kgs. per hectare.

WHOLESALE PRICES OF PRINCIPAL AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES AT PUDUCHERRY AND KARAIKAL MARKETS

The wholesale prices of some important agricultural commodities are collected every week in Puducherry Market and Karaikal Market under “Market Intelligence Scheme”.

It may be noted that the prices of Paddy, Ragi, Cumbu(T.V), Black gram, Green gram, Groundnut (with pods) and Gingelly seeds are collected from the Puducherry Regulated Marketing Committee for Puducherry region.

The analytical note on the price trends in Puducherry and Karaikal Markets is given below:

PADDY

The annual average wholesale price of Paddy (I-sort) in Puducherry Market was at Rs.2,428.61 per quintal and in Karaikal market was at Rs. Rs.2,166.67 per quintal and a mixed trend has been observed during the last five years as may be seen from table -VI..

RICE (BOILED – I SORT)

The annual average wholesale price of Boiled Rice (I-sort) in Puducherry market was reported as Rs.6,007.50 per quintal and in Karaikal market was at Rs. Rs.5,310.00 per quintal during the year 2023-24 and a similar mixed trend as that of Paddy was noticed in the price of rice also during the last five years.

RAGI AND CUMBU

The annual average wholesale price of Ragi in Puducherry market for the year 2023-24 stood at Rs.3,456.13 per quintal as against Rs.2,425.83 in 2022-23 showing an increasing trend and the annual average wholesale price of Cumbu(T.V) was reported as Rs.7,084.22 per quintal in 2023-24 as against Rs.5,062.83 in 2022-23 registering an increasing trend.

The annual average wholesale price of Ragi in Karaikal market for the year 2023-24 stood at Rs.3,591.67 per quintal and cumbu at Rs.4,958.33 showing an increasing trend.

The similar increasing trends prevailed in the Puducherry and Karaikal markets for Pulses, Condiments & Spices, Cane Jaggery, Chillies, Onion, Groundnut (with Pods), Gingelly seeds and Coconut.

WAGES PAID TO AGRICULTURAL LABOURERS

Statistics relating to daily wages paid to agricultural and skilled labourers are collected every month from four selected centres at Puducherry region, two selected centres at Karaikal region and one selected centre at Yanam region of the Union Territory of Puducherry. The agricultural labourers are mainly classified into two groups viz., i) Field Labourers and ii) Skilled labourers.

Field labourers comprise of Ploughmen, Sowers, Transplanters, Weeders, Reapers and Harvesters. Skilled labourers are Carpenters and Blacksmiths. Data regarding average daily wages paid to agricultural labourers during 2023-24 in Puducherry, Karaikal and Yanam regions are detailed in the tables VII-A, VII-B and VII-C(at page No.51-53).

The summary table consists of the average daily wages in respect of the Union Territory of Puducherry. The index numbers of agricultural wages are also given in a separate table taking the agricultural year 2007-08 as base year.

The average daily wages paid to each category of labourers had been computed with simple arithmetic mean of the wage rates that prevailed in the seven selected centers on the last working day of every month during the year 2023-24. The base year average of daily wages has been worked out with the simple average of all the months of the year 2007-08.

The monthly wage relative computed by expressing the average daily wages paid to each category of Labour during a month of the current year as percentage of the corresponding base year average wage rates.

The average daily wages paid (in Rupees) to the agricultural and skilled Labourers in the UT of Puducherry (Pg.32) are detailed below:

FIELD LABOUR

SOWERS AND TRANSPLANTERS

The average daily wages paid to Men was estimated as Rs.650 and that of women was estimated as Rs.410 for the year 2023-24.

WEEDERS

The average daily wages paid to Men was Rs.760 and that of women was reported as Rs.410 for the year 2023-24.

REAPERS AND HARVESTORS

The Harvesting of Paddy is done through Machine in the Puducherry region whereas the Harvesting of Paddy is done manually at some fields of Karaikal and Yanam regions.

The average daily wages paid to Men was Rs.790 whereas to Women was Rs.490.

OTHER AGRICULTURAL LABOURERS

The average daily wages paid to this category men was Rs.750 whereas for women labourers it was reported as Rs.430.

SKILLED LABOURERS

The average daily wages for Carpenters ranged to Rs.870 and the Blacksmith's average wages was reported as Rs.910.

REVIEW ON AGRICULTURAL INDICES

Agricultural Indices are computed with the base year of triennium ending 2007-08 =100. Index numbers for area under all Crops, Net area sown, Yield, Agriculture production, Cropping intensity, productivity per hectare and cropping pattern are constructed.

The index of area under all crops shows a mixed trend due to unstable cropping pattern followed by ryots and availability of water. In 2023-24 the index is 79.97 as compared to 80.04 in 2022-23.

The index of net area sown also varied from year to year. It was 96.27 in 2007-08 whereas in 2023-24 it was 74.98.

The index of yield per hectare crossed the 100 mark for the past fifteen years, which is a good sign of improvement. The current year 2023-24 the index number is 124.95.

The index of agricultural production was 77.11 in the agricultural year 2023-24 whereas, it was 79.74 during 2022-23.

The index of cropping intensity was 106.65 in the year 2023-24, whereas it was 103.83 during 2022-23.

The index of Productivity per hectare stood at 102.84 in the agricultural year 2023-24, as against 103.44 for the agricultural year 2022-23.

The index of cropping pattern was 77.17 in the year 2023-24, whereas it was 79.22 during 2022-23.

AGRICULTURE CENSUS IN THE UNION TERRITORY OF PUDUCHERRY

The U.T of Puducherry has participated in 1970-71 census sponsored by the Government of India for the first time. Data required for the first Agriculture census were collected by the method of re-tabulation of data from the land records. Accordingly, the list of operational holders, along with the particulars of survey numbers operated tenancy details and other particulars like resident/ non-resident were compiled by the Karnams of Revenue Department by re-tabulation of data from the revenue records. The Field Supervisors of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics with the help of the list of holders furnished by the Karnams and the Khasra Registers prepared by them (Field Supervisors). Scrutinize the schedules L1, L2 and L3 and finalize the table on operational holders.

The Tenth Agriculture Census 2015-16 was conducted in the Union Territory on complete enumeration basis in collaboration with the Revenue Department through re-tabulation of data available in the villages land records of the Revenue Department and Khasra register maintained by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics at the village level. The Secretary (Economics and Statistics) and the Director of Economics and Statistics were nominated as Agriculture Census Commissioner and Additional Agriculture Census Commissioner respectively for planning, monitoring and organization of the Census operation in this Union Territory.

The Agriculture Census 2015-16 comprised of two phases viz 1) Agriculture Census 2015-16 and 2) Input Survey 2016-17. Under the Agriculture Census, data were collected for the following 6 characteristics according to 5 size classes of operational holdings: -

- 1) Number and area of operational holdings
- 2) Tenancy/Terms of leasing
- 3) Land Utilization
- 4) Irrigation status and source-wise area irrigated
- 5) Cropping pattern, and
- 6) Dispersal of holdings

- 2) Multiple cropping, separately for irrigated and un-irrigated areas;
- 3) Use of chemical fertilizers, organic manures and pesticides, separately for irrigated and un-irrigated areas under crops;
- 4) Use of agriculture equipment and machines;
- 5) Agriculture credit availed;
- 6) Type of seed used;
- 7) Integrated pest management;
- 8) Size of household, educational qualification of land holder;
- 9) Soil Health/Soil testing.

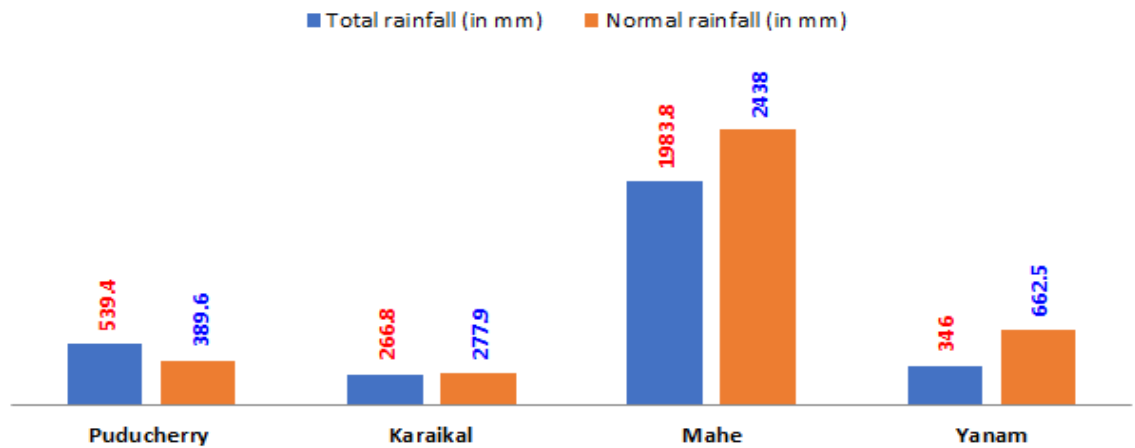

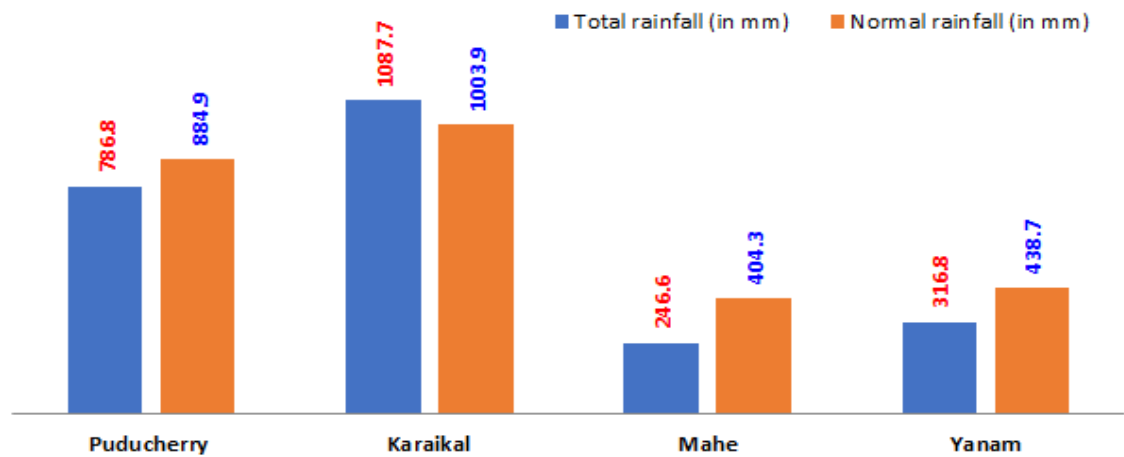

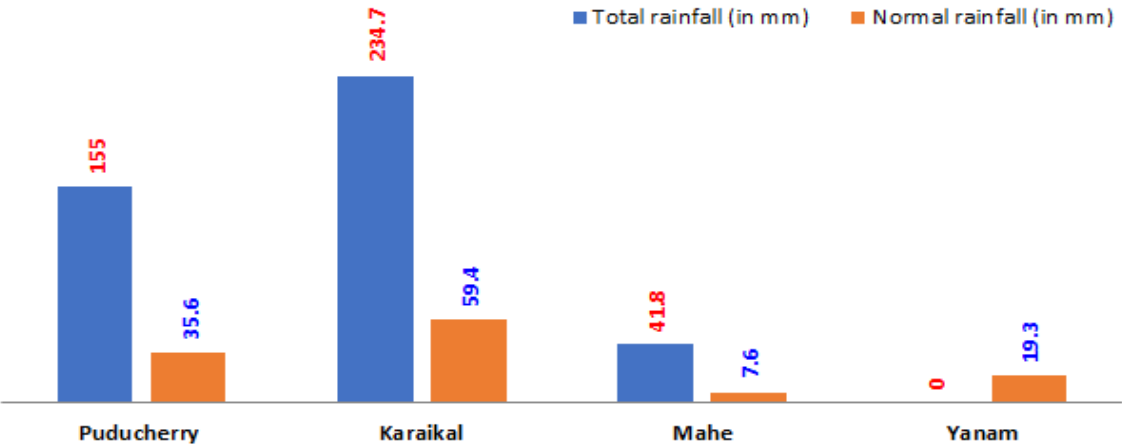
South–West monsoon (June 2023 to September 2023)



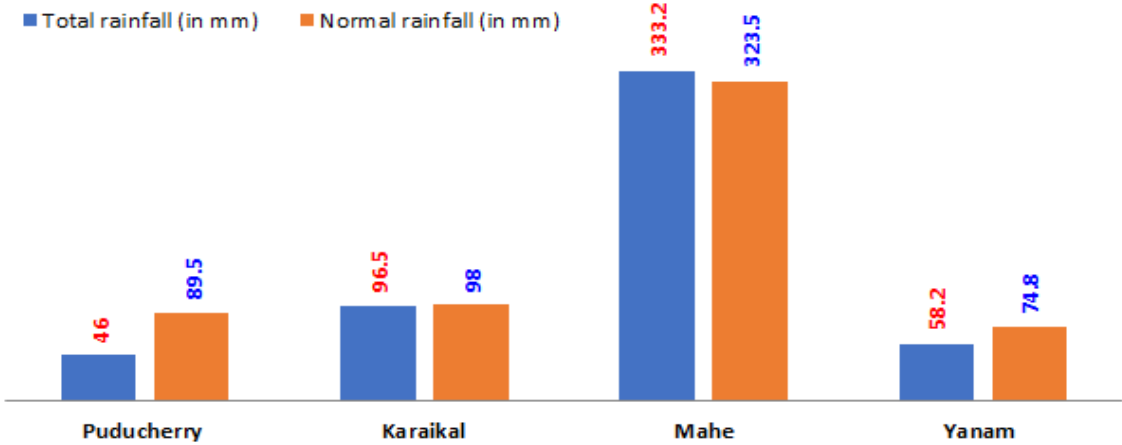
North–East monsoon (October 2023 to December 2023)

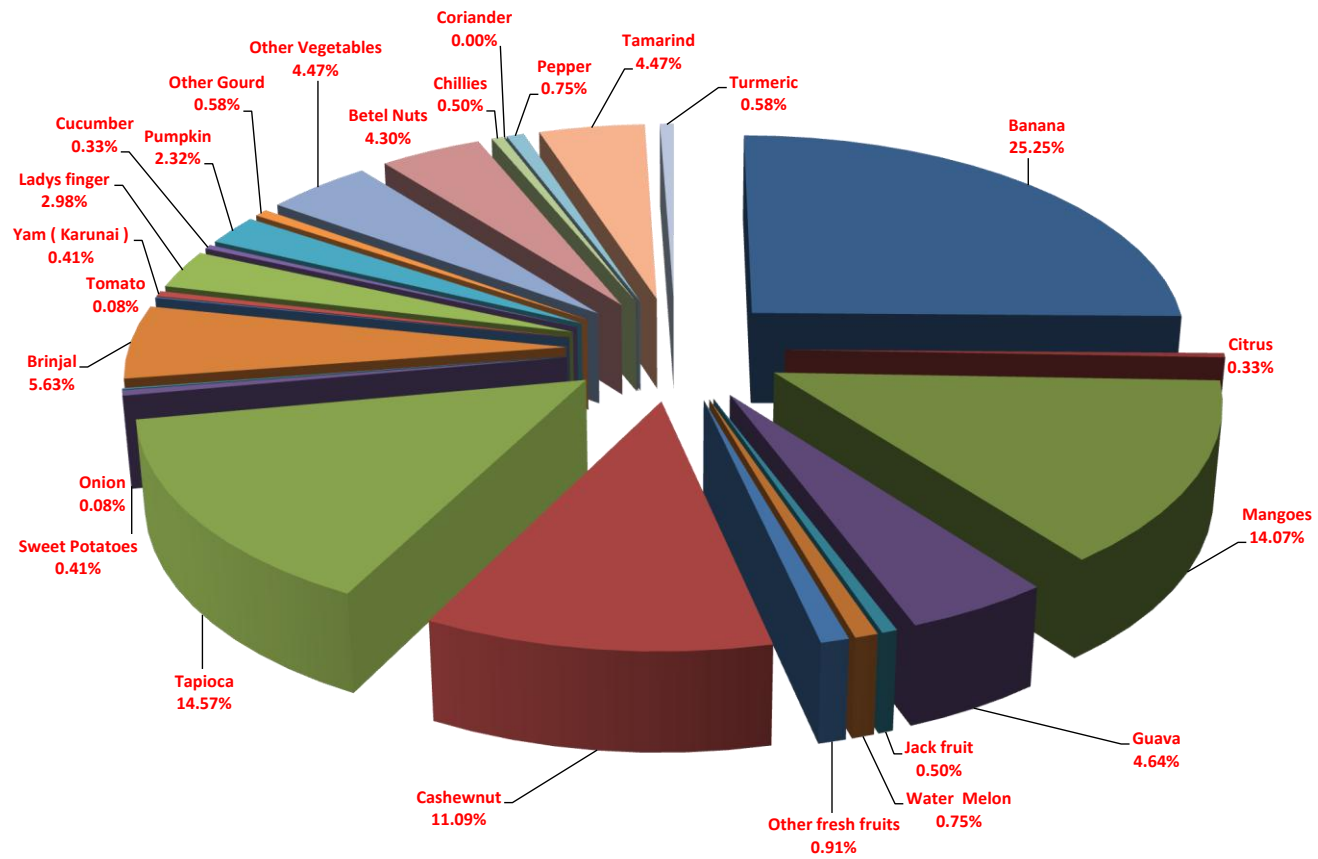
