Trends in Components of Non-Tax Revenue 2009-10 to 2011-12:

All sources of Non-Tax Revenue viz Interest, Receipts, Dividends and Profits and income from General Services, Social Services increased any in absolute terms but, Economic Services decreased. Income from Economic Services decreased by 98.43% from ` .556.13 crore in 2009-10 to ` .8.72 crore in 2011-12 and its contribution to total non- tax revenue also decreased from 86.50% in 2009-10 to 6.71% in 2011-12. Interest, Receipts, Dividends and Profits, income from General services and Social services increased by 55.32%, 22.12% and 15.25% respectively. But, the contribution of these sources to total non tax revenue has decreased marginally decreased by 79.78% from 2009-10 to 2011-12, its contribution to total Non Tax Revenue decreases marginally.
