Grants-in-Aid from the Government of India:

The Table - 7 shows the Grants-in-Aid received from the Government of India during the years 2009-10, 2010-11 and 2011-12. The Grants-in-Aid received from Govt of India has decreased by 0.58 percent from `. 1330.66 crore in 2009-10 to `.1322.96 crore in 2011-12.

Expenditure met from Revenue 2010–11 (B.E):

Budget Estimates of Expenditure under the Revenue Account for 2011-12 is placed at `.3776.77 crore, which is 22.49 percent higher than the actual expenditure incurred during the year 2009-10.Out of the total expenditure of `.3776.77 crore, `.2814.05 crore (74.51%) is earmarked for development purposes, which is `.601.80 crore higher than the expenditure incurred in 2009-10. Non-Development expenditure is estimated at `.962.73 crore or10.51%, which is `.91.52 crore higher than that of 2009-10.
