NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Notification No. 5/4/65-GP., dated 11th January, 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, and in supersession of the Notification No. 11032/62-CD, dated 2-6-1965 of the erstwhile Planning and Development Department, Pondicherry, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'B' posts of Deputy Director of Economics and Statistics in the Government of Pondicherry, namely:—

1. *Short title.*—These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Group 'B' Post of Deputy Director and Evaluation Officer of Economics and Statistics Recruitment Rules, 1984.

2. *Application.*— These rules shall apply for recruitment to the posts specified in column 1 of the schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Number of posts, their classifications and scale of pay.*— The number of the said posts, their classifications and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in the schedule annexed hereto.

4. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said schedule.

5. *Disqualifications.*— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. *Power to relax.*—Where the Lieutenant-Governor, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. *Savings.*—(1) Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard;

(2) Nothing in these rules shall affect the appointments and promotions already made in accordance with the rules hereby superseded.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR AND EVALUATION OFFICER

9. Period of probation, if any Two years.
10. Method of recruitment whether by direct or by promotion or by deputation/transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.
- (i) 75% by promotion failing which by transfer on deputation and failing both by direct recruitment.
- (ii) 25% by direct recruitment.
11. In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer is to be made.
- Promotion :**
Research Assistant with 3 year's regular service in the grade and possessing the educational qualification as indicated in column 8.
- Transfer on deputation :**
Officers under the Central / State Governments / Union territories:
- (a) (i) holding analogous posts; or
(ii) with 3 year's service in posts in the scale of Rs. 550-900 or equivalent; or
(iii) with 8 year's service in posts in the scale of Rs. 425-700 or equivalent; and
- (b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 7.
- (The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same organisation/department shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years).
12. If a Departmental Promotion Committee/ Recruitment Committee exists, what is its composition?
- Group 'B' Departmental Promotion Committee:
- (i) Chief Secretary—Chairman.
(ii) Secretary (Statistics)—Member.
(iii) Director of Economics and Statistics—Member.
- Note** - The proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation shall be sent to the Commission for approval. If, however, they are not approved by the Commission a fresh meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or a Member of the Union Public Service Commission shall be held.
13. Circumstances in which Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment.
- Consultation with the Union Public Service Commission necessary while making direct recruitment, selecting an officer for appointment on deputation and amending/relaxing any of the provisions of these rules.
