

H I G H L I G H T S

- **194662 persons are employed in 49574 enterprises engaged in different economic activities other than Crop Production and Plantation in the Union Territory.**
- **Out of 49574 enterprises located in the Union Territory, 25465 (51.37%) are Own Account enterprises and 24109 (48.63%) are Establishments.**
- **Of the total enterprises, 16811 (33.91%) enterprises are located in rural areas and 32763 (66.09%) are in urban areas.**
- **Out of the total enterprises in the Union Territory, 4337 enterprises (8.75%) are involved in Agricultural activities and 45237 (91.25%) are involved in Non-Agricultural activities.**
- **Out of the 24109 Establishments, 1091 (4.53%) Establishments are engaged in Agricultural activities and 23018 (95.47%) are engaged in Non-Agricultural activities in the Union Territory.**
- **63564 persons (32.65%) are employed in rural areas and 131098 persons (67.35%) are employed in urban areas.**
- **Out of 4337 Agricultural Enterprises, 3498 (80.65%) Enterprises are located in rural areas and 839 (19.35%) are in urban areas.**
- **The Major Activity Group in Non-Agricultural enterprises is Retail Trade with 45.17% followed by Manufacturing with 13.58% and Other Community Personal services with 7.73%.**

- **The percentage of enterprises in Education sector is 2.93% which occupies 9th rank in the Major Activity Group among Non-agricultural enterprises group.**
- **Out of 187033 persons employed in Non-agricultural enterprises, the concentration of persons working is more in Manufacturing sector followed by Retail Trade with 50197 and 37404 respectively.**
- **About 37044 enterprises are owned by SC, ST and OBC persons in the Union Territory. The number of enterprises owned by S.C persons are 2383 (4.81%), S.T persons are 428 (0.86%) and OBC are 34233 (69.05%).**
- **The number of Enterprises in the size class of 1-5 employment is accounted for 99.92% of the total Enterprises. A similar trend has also been observed in both rural and urban sectors under the same size class of 1-5 employment.**
- **The percentage of female workers in agriculture enterprises both in rural and urban areas is 17.56% to the total workers during 5th Economic Census while it was 2.70% during 4th Economic Census.**
- **The number of male and female child labour has drastically declined by 76% and 67% during 5th Economic Census 2005 over 4th Economic Census 1998.**
- **The number of enterprises and in the number of persons usually working are more in urban areas than rural areas.**
