

VI. PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN IN THE ECONOMY

As regards the participation of women and men in the economy, it is a fact that men earn more than women, men occupy more management positions and a greater proportion of key skills jobs in Engineering and Information & Communication technology.

Males dominate many industries because of their education and gender. Women are not qualified for many jobs due to their lack of education. Women compete for jobs and get less wages due to unskilled labour force. While women pushed out of jobs by technology, many go to the unorganized sector to earn money.

It is a known fact that there is a wide difference in the participation of women and men in the economy. It is proved that about 23.78% of women in rural areas and 13.61% of women in urban areas were in the work force as compared to 54.47% of men in rural and 52.68% of men in urban areas during 2001 in the Union Territory of Pondicherry.

In 1991, about 6.80% of women in the work force(main workers) were at the educational level of graduates and above as compared to 8.40% of men. A major 57.10% of women in the work force(main workers) were illiterate as compared to 20.60% of men.

Major industry group wise distribution of employment indicates that the concentration of female employment is more in the group of Community, Social and Personal services contributing about 24%, followed by Hotel and Restaurant(23%), Manufacturing(21%) and Retail trade(18%) during 1998.

In the organised sector, out of the total employees, about 18.93% were women in 2002 as compared to 15.08% in 2001. The proportion of women employees was higher in the public sector(19.11%) as compared to that in the private sector(18.32%) in 2002. It is observed that the share of women in total employment was only 20.51% in non-agricultural establishments. This clearly indicates the gender based differences of choice and opportunities in various occupations and wide difference in the participation of women and men in the economy.

Women usually spend a higher proportion of their income they earn, on food and basic needs i.e. for purchase of goods and services that promote nutrition, health and general well-being of their families. Hence, increasing women's income can have a greater positive impact on these outcomes. The effect of women's income also has a benefit on women's own dietary intake. Hence there is a need to enhance the knowledge and income of women.

The average daily wages of women in Agricultural activities was Rs.37.16 as compared to Rs.92.38 for men during 2000-01. The differences prevalent in the average daily wages of women and men is also an evident for gender discrimination.

The involvement of women in micro, small and medium sized enterprises continues to rise and almost everywhere more women are working outside the household, where the right to a safe and healthy workplace and freedom from sexual harassment should be seen as basic human rights. The rate of women migrant workers including domestic workers are at an increasing trend, contribute to the economy of the sending country through their remittances and also to the economy of the receiving country through their participation in the labour force.

As per the prevailing nature of political system, women face severe handicaps. Neither they are located visibly as a group nor they are structurally brought together like a class. Thus women's movements have low political influence.

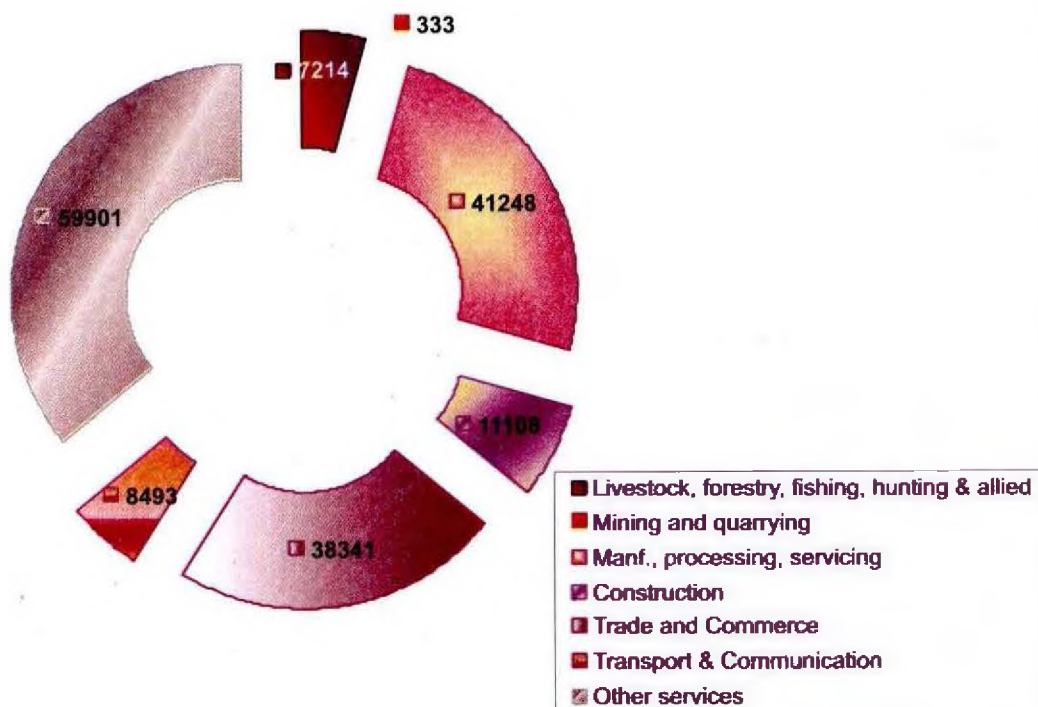

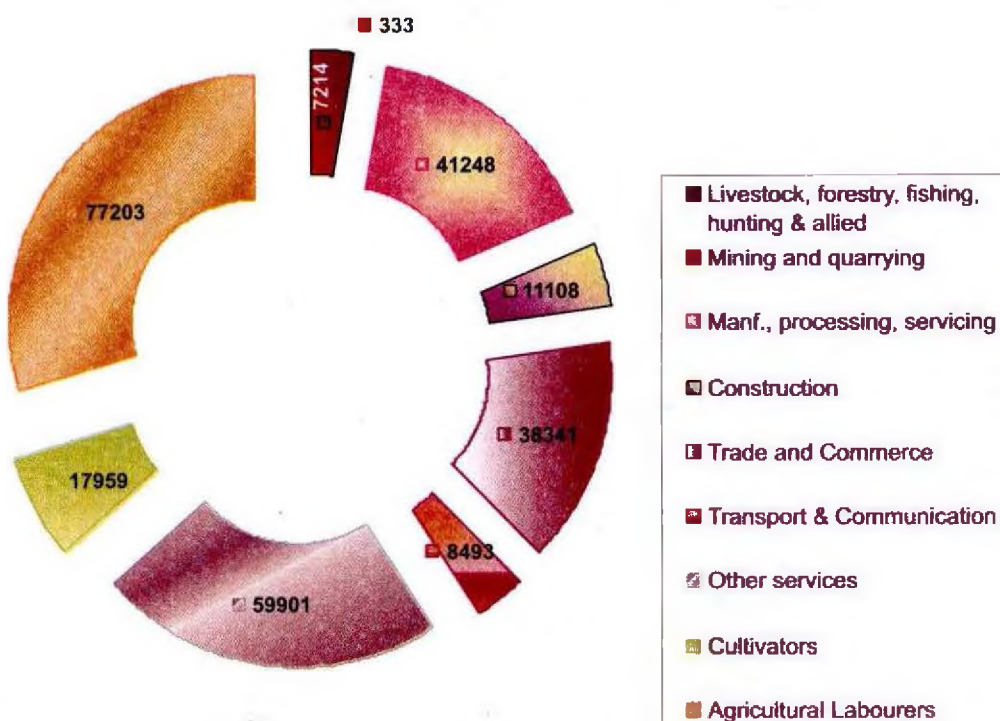

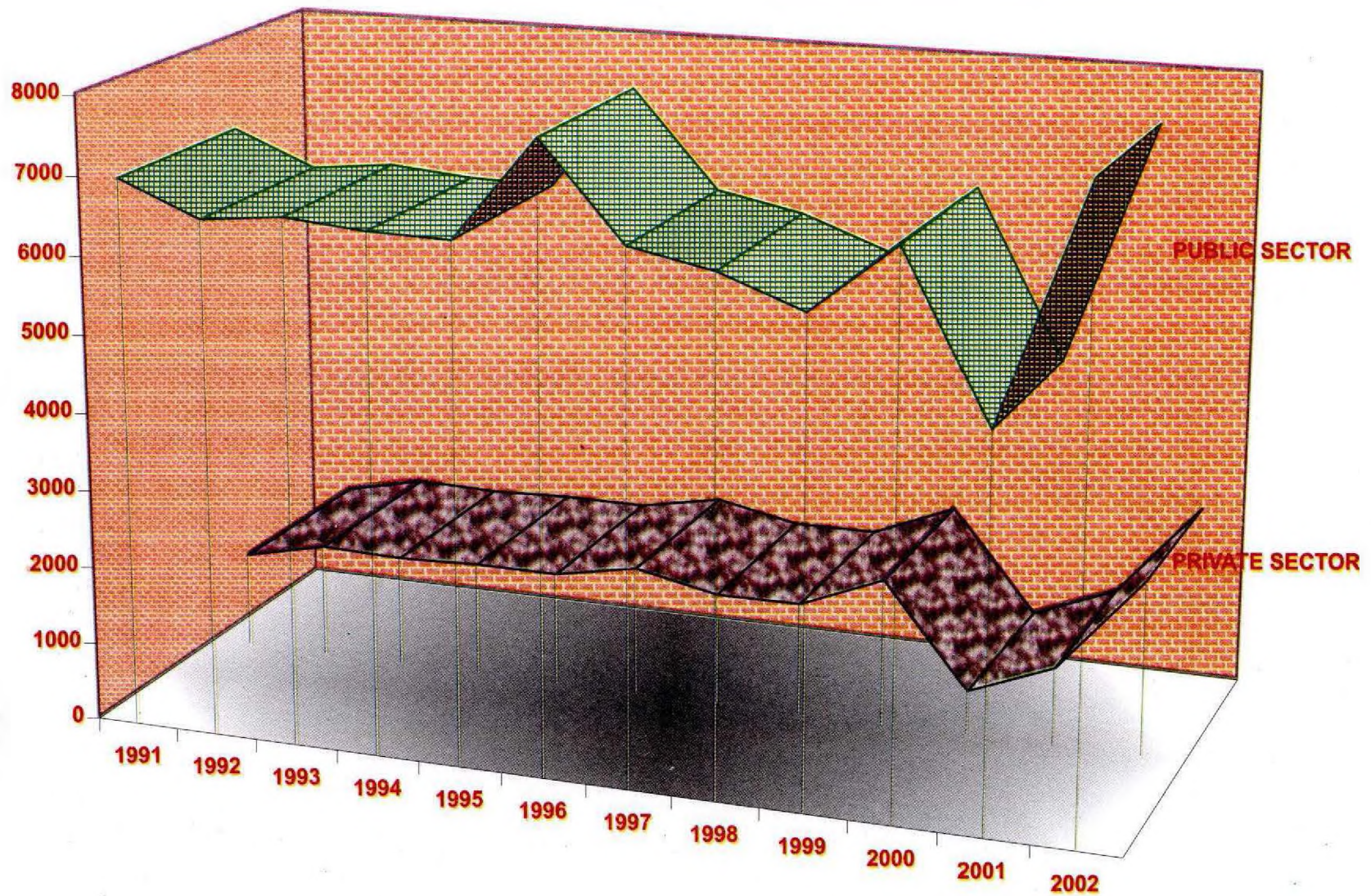
