Absolute population of the country is its most important demographic indicator. The population of the Union Territory had been increasing steadily since the beginning of the 20th Century. It has almost increased five times during the period from 1901 to 2011. However the increase during 1901 to 1951 was not high. After 1951 the rate of growth became faster mainly due to decrease in the death rate because of various health interventions. The decadal growth rate has increased from 20.62 in 2001 to 27.72 in 2011
