Table 3 gives the details of family planning acceptors by methods in the U. T of Puducherry. In 2009-10 number of women underwent sterilization (Tubectomy) stands at 9359. The total Family Planning acceptors in 2009-10 were 22,899. Sterilization was the most widely used method protecting about 40.97% of eligible couples followed by Conventional contraceptives (40.84%) and IUD (10.8%) in the Union Territory of Puducherry. The awareness of female sterilization was very high in both urban and rural areas in Puducherry. However, the use of modern methods in the age-group of 20-24 may be encouraged to reduce early age pregnancy to ensure reduction in infant/maternal mortality rate. For the well being of the mother as well as for the entire family, there should be an improvement in the usage of contraceptives and Family Planning Methods. This would give better chances to women to achieve the desired size of the family with the reduced number of pregnancies and help to ensure desired gap of the consecutive pregnancies.
