The unemployment rate of females in rural is 50 as against 218 in urban. On the other hand, the unemployment rate of male is 120 in rural and 42 in urban. In case of both males and females, the unemployment rate has increased from 1999-00 to 2004-05. The State Government has to concentrate on policies and programmes for improving employment opportunities.

The table 4 reveals that average disguised unemployment rate in the Informal Service Sector is generally high in respect of females when compared with males both in urban and rural areas. The disguised unemployment in respect of females in urban is high when compared with rural.
